## **TWO Grant Opportunities Announced This Week From Preserve New York and the BU Philanthropy Incubator**

### **Preserve New York State 2023 grant cycle is now open!**

The 2023 Preserve New York grant cycle funds historic preservation planning projects for NYS not-for-profits and units of local government. ### **Binghamton University Philanthropy Incubator is Seeking Inquiries From Non-Profits Operating in Broome County**

As in past years, Binghamton University students will have grant money to distribute to local nonprofit organizations this year. The money will be available through two classes, one undergraduate class (with approximately \$10,000) and

one graduate class (with at least \$3,000). The undergraduate students receive the grant funds they distribute from The Learning by Giving Foundation and the Conrad and Virginia Klee Foundation. The graduate students raise the money they distribute through a Party with a Purpose fundraiser. To be eligible for funding, organizations must be 501(c)3 and operate in the Broome County area (broadly defined).

Because many students are unfamiliar with the range of organizations in the Broome County area, we would like them to learn about as many prospective grantees as possible. The approach we have come up with is to ask representatives of local nonprofit organizations interested in funding from the class to fill out [this simple information form](#). If your organization wants to be considered for funding, please complete ***the form by midnight, Friday, Jan. 27.***

The students will follow up with the five finalists for their class, possibly soliciting a more detailed proposal and, in all cases requesting a site visit (which may take place virtually) or interviews with key staff and potential clients. ***This year, ALL FINALIST ORGANIZATIONS WILL RECEIVE A \$500 award in recognition of the time and effort it takes to work with each class and acknowledge each finalist organization's contribution to students' learning.***

Organizations selected as finalists will find out at different times, based on the schedule for each course. We will determine finalists for the two courses by March 1.
